

JOINT MEETING

VILLAGE OF COTTAGE GROVE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
JANUARY 6, 2012

1. Roll Call and Meeting Properly Posted:
  - A. Notice of the meeting was properly posted in the Town. Town Chair Kris Hampton and Town Supervisors Mike Fonger, Steve Anders, Mike Kindschi and Mike DuPlayee were present.
  - B. Notice of the meeting was properly posted in the Village. Village President Diane Wiedenbeck and Trustees David Viken, Micah Zielke, Jeff Weigand, Ken Dahl and Jennifer Pickel were present. Paula Severson was absent and excused.
  - C. Town Clerk Kim Banigan and Police Sergeant David Stortz were also present.
2. Call to order:
  - A. Hampton called the Town Board to order at 6:30 P.M.
  - B. Wiedenbeck called the Village Board to order at 6:30 P.M.
3. Discuss/Consider approval of minutes from November 3, 2011 meeting: **MOTION** by Zielke/Kindschi to approve the November 3, 2011 minutes as printed. **MOTION CARRIED 10-0-1** (Weigand abstained).
4. Discuss/Consider placing stop signs at the corner of Sandpiper Trail and Mourning Dove Drive: Pickel stated that she found the intersection tricky and felt it would be safer with a 4-way stop (currently there are stop signs on Mourning Dove but not on Sandpiper). **MOTION** by Zielke/DuPlayee to not place any more stop signs at the corner of Sandpiper Trail and Mourning Dove Drive. **MOTION CARRIED 10-1** (Pickel opposed).
5. Discuss/Consider posting 'No Weapons' signs at the Emergency Services Building: **MOTION** by Fonger/Zielke to not post 'No Weapons' signs at the Emergency Services Building. **MOTION CARRIED 11-0.**
6. Update on December police department billing to the Town: Hampton reported that the police billing to the Town is complete through November, and the December invoice is due on January 20<sup>th</sup>.
7. Update on Police Department vacancies: Sgt. Stortz reported that Police Commission interviews of Chief candidates are scheduled for this Saturday, with another round planned for January 21<sup>st</sup> in conjunction with a meet-and-greet. The commission will need to go back to square one in hiring for the officer position since previously qualified applicants are no longer interested.
8. Adjournment:
  - A. **MOTION** by DuPlayee/Kindschi to adjourn the Town Board. **MOTION CARRIED 5-0.**
  - B. **MOTION** by Zielke/Pickel to adjourn the Village Board. **MOTION CARRIED 4-0.**
