NOTICE OF REFERENDUM ELECTION
DEERFIELD COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

TAKE NOTICE that a referendum election shall be held on November 8, 2016 in the Deerfield Community School District for the purpose of approving or rejecting a Revenue Cap Resolution adopted by the School Board of said School District on August 29, 2016 and an Initial Resolution adopted by the School Board of said District on August 30, 2016.

The Revenue Cap Resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP
COMMENCING WITH
THE 2016-17 SCHOOL YEAR
BY AN AMOUNT OF \$400,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Deerfield Community School District, Dane County, Wisconsin, that the final school district budget shall include an amount not to exceed \$400,000 in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes each year for a period of four years on a nonrecurring basis, beginning with the 2016-17 school year and ending with the 2019-20 school year, for the purpose of maintaining instructional programs, maintaining facilities, providing secure buildings, upgrading technology, and meeting the operating expense requirements incurred when properly operating the educational facilities of the District during these school years.

The referendum ballot will ask District electors: “Shall the School Board of the Deerfield Community School District be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes by an amount of \$400,000 each year for a period of four years, beginning with the 2016-17 school year and ending with the 2019-20 school year, on a nonrecurring basis for the purpose of maintaining instructional programs, maintaining facilities, providing secure buildings, upgrading technology, and meeting the operating expense requirements incurred when properly operating the educational facilities of the District during these school years as provided in the foregoing resolution?”

A “yes” vote is in favor of the resolution set forth above and is a vote to approve exceeding the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes by an amount of \$400,000 each year for a period of four years on a nonrecurring basis, beginning with the 2016-17 school year and ending with the 2019-20 school year, for the purpose of maintaining instructional programs, maintaining facilities, providing secure buildings, upgrading technology, and meeting the operating expense requirements incurred when properly operating the educational facilities of the District during these school years.

A “no” vote is opposed to the resolution and is a vote to deny exceeding the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes by an amount of \$400,000 each year for a period

of four years on a nonrecurring basis, beginning with the 2016-17 school year and ending with the 2019-20 school year, for the purpose of maintaining instructional programs, maintaining facilities, providing secure buildings, upgrading technology, and meeting the operating expense requirements incurred when properly operating the educational facilities of the District during these school years.

The Initial Resolution reads as follows:

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$2,900,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Deerfield Community School District, Dane County, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2,900,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of renovations, repairs and infrastructure improvements to school district buildings and grounds to address key areas of need, improving school security and construction of a new multi-use fitness center/weight room, stadium press box and concession area and replacement of bleacher facilities.

The referendum ballot will ask District electors: “Shall the foregoing resolution of the School Board of the Deerfield Community School District be approved?”

A “yes” vote is in favor of the Initial Resolution set forth above and is a vote to approve the borrowing of not to exceed \$2,900,000 by the Deerfield Community School District through the issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the purpose of paying the costs of renovations, repairs and infrastructure improvements to school district buildings and grounds to address key areas of need, improving school security and construction of a new multi-use fitness center/weight room, stadium press box and concession area and replacement of bleacher facilities.

A “no” vote is opposed to the Initial Resolution and is a vote to deny the Deerfield Community School District the authority to borrow not to exceed \$2,900,000 through the issuance of General Obligation Bonds for the purpose of paying the costs of renovations, repairs and infrastructure improvements to school district buildings and grounds to address key areas of need, improving school security and construction of a new multi-use fitness center/weight room, stadium press box and concession area and replacement of bleacher facilities.
