<p><b>Judicial</b></p>	<p><b>State</b></p>	<p>BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Deerfield Community School District, Dane County, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$49,700,000 for the purpose of paying the costs of renovating and expanding the middle/high school building and grounds to address aging building infrastructure and undersized classrooms and support areas including enhanced building safety and security; Americans with Disabilities Act compliance improvements; upgrades to building mechanical systems; updates to exterior building sections; windows, flooring and door replacements; a maintenance department addition; a sixth grade classroom addition; an addition for classrooms, science labs and areas to support hands-on collaborative learning; building a dedicated music area, library media center and cafeteria and kitchen; renovating and modernizing all existing classrooms and support areas; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.</p>
